About This Guide

This Install Guide documents the installation process on a B8 Audi S5. There may be minor differences depending on specific vehicle, market, options, etc.

We recommend replacing your oil filter, along with the gasket and o-ring. If yours are fairly new, you can reuse them.



Install Steps

Step 1

Open your hood.



Step 2

Using a 36mm socket, loosen the factory oil filter housing.



Step 3

Lay down some rags to soak up any stray oil drips.



Step 4Quickly remove the housing.





Step 5Remove the oil filter.




Step 6Remove the o-ring from the oil filter provision on the engine.



Step 7

Install the new o-ring onto the oil filter provision on the engine.



Step 8

Rub some oil along the o-ring to prevent tearing.

Step 9

Install the new gasket into the oil filter housing. It may seem like it's too big, but it will fit with some patience.





Step 10

Gently remove the oil filter tube from the old housing.



Step 11

Transfer the tube to the 034 oil filter housing. There should be an audible indication that it has bottomed out.




Step 12

Install a fresh oil filter. There should be another audible indication that the filter has bottomed out.



Step 13

Thread the 034 oil filter housing onto the engine.






Step 14
Using a 36mm socket, secure the housing.
Torque to 25Nm+5.



Step 15 Clean up any stray oil.



Step 16 Admire that sexy new engine accessory.



Step 17Close your hood and you're done. Enjoy!
